4. FIRST-AID MEASURES

Eye Contact	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes; remove contact lenses if present; seek medical attention if irritation persists.
Skin Contact	Wash with plenty of water; remove contaminated clothing; not expected to be irritating under normal use.
Inhalation	Move to fresh air; not expected to be hazardous by inhalation under normal use; mist/vapor at high concentration may cause mild irritation.
Ingestion	Rinse mouth with water; not expected to require treatment for small amounts; seek medical advice if a large quantity is swallowed.

5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

Suitable Extinguishing Media	Water spray/fog, carbon dioxide, dry chemical, alcohol-resistant foam.
Unsuitable Extinguishing Media	None known; avoid a solid water stream that could spread burning liquid.
Special Hazards	Combustible liquid with a relatively high flash point; heating may release irritating vapors/fumes; combustion produces carbon oxides.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Measures	Contain the spill, absorb with inert absorbent material, and collect in suitable containers; spilled material is slippery; ventilate the area; avoid large discharge to drains/waterways.
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7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling Precautions	Avoid eye contact; use with adequate ventilation; keep away from open flames and heat sources; follow good hygiene/handling practices for food-grade liquids.
Storage Conditions	Store in tightly closed containers in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from strong oxidizing agents and open flames; hygroscopic, protect from moisture ingress.

8. EXPOSURE CONTROLS / PERSONAL PROTECTION

Exposure Limits / PPE	ACGIH TLV of 10 mg/m3 (TWA) commonly referenced for propylene glycol aerosol/mist; use safety glasses and gloves; respiratory protection not normally needed under typical handling.

Stability	Stable under normal conditions of storage and handling; hygroscopic; combustible at elevated temperatures.
Incompatible Materials	Strong oxidizing agents, strong acids.
Hazardous Decomposition	Thermal decomposition may produce carbon monoxide, carbon dioxide, and traces of aldehydes (e.g., propionaldehyde).

11. TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Summary	Very low acute toxicity (rat oral LD50 approximately 20,000 mg/kg); not classified as an irritant, sensitizer, mutagen, reproductive toxicant, or carcinogen; an extensively studied food, pharmaceutical, and cosmetic excipient with a long history of safe use.
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12. ECOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Summary	Readily biodegradable; low toxicity to aquatic organisms; not expected to bioaccumulate; may contribute to biochemical oxygen demand in concentrated discharges.
